7:30 pm	Ian Doyle and 'Source to Sea' talk and film, at the Barn

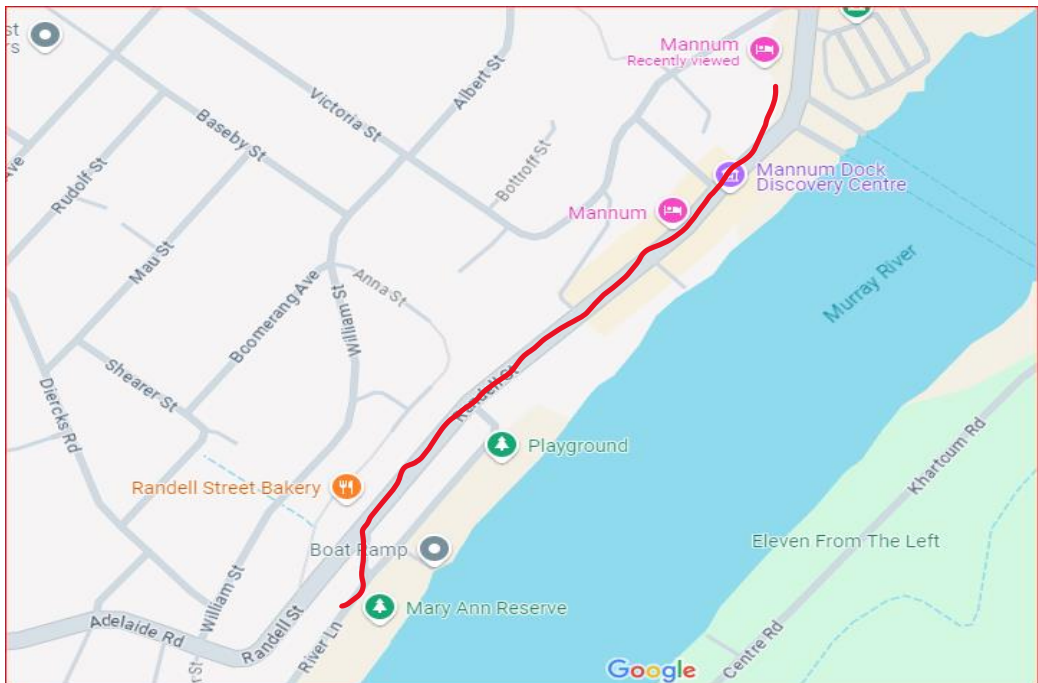


Please remember:

- Update your vehicle log books daily, as required
- Your lanyard / name badge is in the rally pack and gives you access to some activities. There are also vouchers in the rally pack for other activities.
- Please stick the "Shannons" number on the windscreen of your car, so that judges at the "show & shine" know whose car belongs to whom.
- The museum pass in the rally pack is for 2 people for the whole time of the rally. You can visit the museum as often as you like.

7:00 – 8:30	Breakfast available at the motel at your expense
9:00	The Barn - briefing
9:00- 9:30	The Barn - vehicles depart at 1 minute intervals for the car show at Mary Anne Reserve, approx. 1 km. Photos of your car will be taken at Mary Anne Reserve
10:00	Mary Anne Reserve – Hillman “Show & Shine”. In the rally pack, there is a \$20 voucher for each person for the Randell St Bakery, which is just across the road from the Reserve. Suit yourself whether you want morning tea or lunch or whatever. Be warned, though, the cakes are awesome.
11:00	Mary Anne Reserve - Mayflower 1 hr cruise Group A
1:00 pm	Mary Anne Reserve - Mayflower 1 hr cruise Group B
	NOTE – the paddle steamer Mayflower leaves from Mary Anne Reserve, so you can leave your car at the “Show & Shine” until you come back from the cruise. There will be someone to watch the cars while you are away.
4:00 pm	The Barn – Bus tour departs for Ngaut Ngaut Conservation Park. There will be a welcome by local aboriginal guides, lots of stories, and a bit of a nature walk. It may pay to bring a jumper or coat, just in case it cools down.
	Dinner will be at Walkers Flat on the way back to Mannum. Return to Mannum approx. 9:00pm.

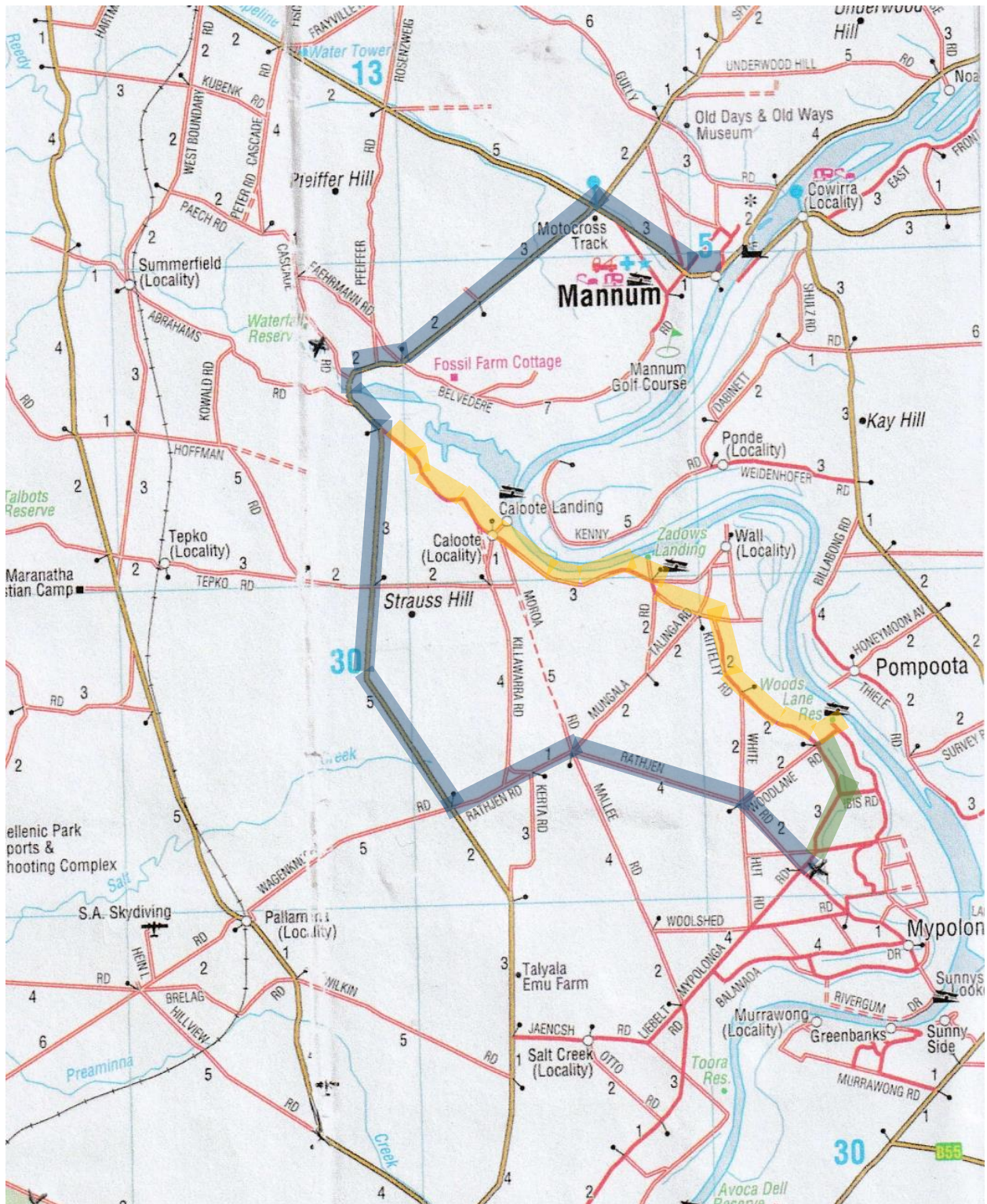


Map of Mannum Motel to Mary Ane Reserve

- 8:00 – 10:00** Breakfast available at the motel at your expense.
- 9:00** The Barn - briefing
- 10:30** Depart from the Barn, and drive to Aussie Apricots, Mypolonga, approx. 26 km
- 11:00** Tour of Aussie Apricots, then drive approx. 500m back to Revolution Motor Museum. Lunch is provided by our hosts, Paul & Kathy. After lunch, have a good look around the museum and vehicle restoration workshop.
- 2:30 pm approx.** Drive to Wood Lane Reserve. Tea and coffee and cold drinks will be provided. Also supplied is a packet of home-made goodies from the Mannum Hospital Auxiliary.
- 6:30 pm** Mannum Motel – rally dinner and presentations in the dining room at the Motel. Dress code for the rally dinner is "Riverboat" i.e. very casual, whatever you would wear on a houseboat holiday, or anything nautical. The bar will be open early.

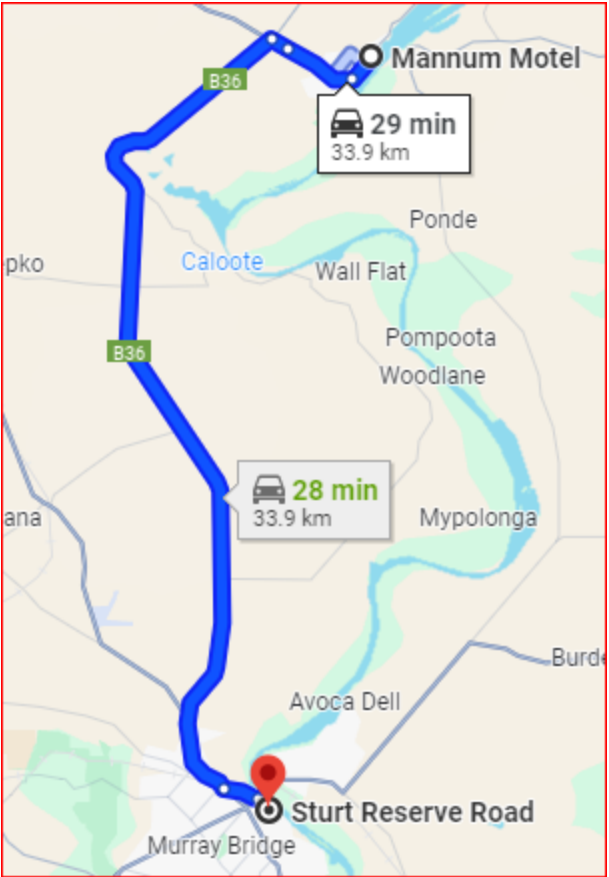




Map of route: - Mannum to Mypolonga

Wood Lane Reserve to Mannum

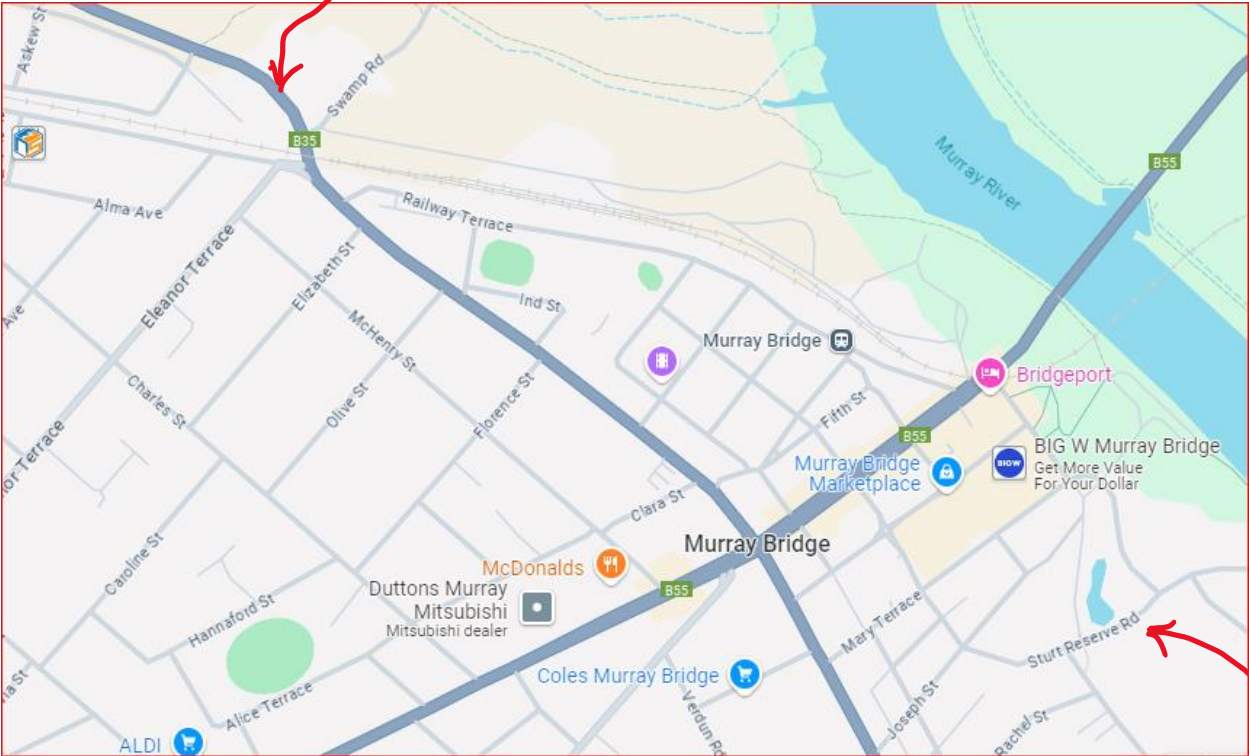
Monday 21 Oct

8:00 – 10:00	Breakfast available at the motel at your expense.
9:00	The Barn - briefing
9:15	The Barn - Group A drive to Sturt Reserve, Murray Bridge, approx. 32 km.
10:00	At Sturt Reserve. Group A , 1 hour cruise on ‘Four Knots’ river boat, including morning tea. Park in any marked parking places as near as possible to the boat.
10:15	The Barn - Group B drive to Sturt Reserve, Murray Bridge, approx. 32 km.
11:00	At Sturt Reserve. Group B , 1 hour cruise on ‘Four Knots’ river boat, including morning tea. Park in any marked parking places as near as possible to the boat.
After Cruise	Sturt Reserve - drive to Monarto Safari Park. Entry vouchers to Monarto Safari Park are in the rally pack. There is no special tour of the park. Please just look around at your leisure and join one of the Zoo-loop buses which run all day. A light lunch will be provided in the Zoo café, at any time to suit you. Please show your rally lanyard for payment.
At Monarto	Please stay as long as you like until the Park closes at 5:00 pm When you exit the Park, turn left. At the next intersection, which is the main Mannum Road, turn right back to Mannum. CAUTION – this is a dangerous intersection with fast traffic. Return to Mannum, approx. 33 km.
6:30 pm	Pretoria Hotel – walk from the Motel or Caravan Park to the Pretoria for a casual Hillman dinner at the hotel. Meal vouchers will be handed out at the time.
